STUDENT ART CONTEST ENTRY & SUBMISSION CRITERIA

1. Contestants must be a resident of Maui County
2. Completed hand drawn/painted work on paper should not exceed 8-1/2" x 11" (No frames or mounted pieces)
3. All mediums are allowed – pencil, colored pencil, pen, marker, paint etc.
4. All art entries should depict Queen Ka'ahumanu. We encourage students to research Her Majesty's legacy on line to inspire your art.
5. Each entry must have a completed official entry form, along with disclaimer form (parental signatures are required), taped to the back of the artwork to be accepted
6. Entries will be accepted at the QKC Guest Services desk from Monday, March 13 through to the Festival on Saturday, March 18 by 10:30 am.
7. Judging will begin promptly at 10:30 a.m. at the festival. Winners will be announced at the Center Court Stage at 2:00 pm.
8. Artwork should be picked up at exhibit area by 2:30pm, otherwise include a self-addressed stamped envelope for return of artwork. Artwork will not be returned if an envelope is not provided.

Submissions will be judged in three age divisions.

Select based on the grade you are currently enrolled Winter/Spring 2017:
3rd grade – 5th grade | 6th grade – 8th grade | 9th grade – 12th grade

The top three (3) winning contestants (1 from each age division)
will be awarded grand prizes.
